## **Are you an Armed Forces veteran aged 60? Could you be eligible for a Service Pension?**

In this day and age, it's important to know about all your financial entitlements . . .

If you can answer yes to the following questions, then you may be eligible for a preserved pension:

- Are you ex-Service?
- Have you served in the Armed Forces since 1975?
- Are you 60 or over?

The latest Service Personnel and Veterans Agency (SPVA) [podcast](#) aims to provide some answers on preserved pensions from eligibility to the applications process.

Lt Paul Harvey RN, SPVA pensions, explains:

“We want to make sure veterans are aware of their entitlement to preserved pensions. We need to stress the importance of writing to us when they are nearing 60, to claim for the pension allowance they are [due](#).”
