COMMEMORATION CEMETERY HEIDEHOF

Date: Friday April 16 th Time: 10.00 until 12.00

Location: Cemetery Heidehof at Uchgelen(Apeldoorn)

Programme:

- 10.00 Reception of guests in the pavilion of the cemetery.
- 10.30 Address of welcome by the Chairman of the working-groupe.
Commemoration address by the Chairman of the foundation.
Liberation 45 Mr. R. Seijn(Gen. Rtd).
Reflection by the Hon. Revd. Jeffrey Allen.
Short musical intermezzo.
Addresses by pupils group 7 and 8 of the local Christian Primary school Bouwhof.
Organ-playing.
- 11.00 Silent walk to the 57 graves of allied service men who lost their lives in the battles fought on the ground and in the air around Apeldoorn, preceded by the school-children.
- 11.30 Ceremonial at the Monument Cross of Sacrifice:
-Short introduction
-Last Post, Taptoe, 2 min. silence, Signal
-Short Prayer by The Hon, Revd. Jeffrey Allen, followed by reading out the names of the killed airmen. Simultaneously the schoolchildren place a floral tribute at the respective grave.
-Laying of wreaths by authorities who gave notice of this intention.
During this ceremony a band plays chorale music. Authorities laying the wreaths will be assisted by the schoolchildren.
-Short roll of drums.
-Signal Attention
-Display of the National Flags whilst the band plays short the respective national anthems in the following order:
United Kingdom, Australia, Canada, Tsjechia, New Zeeland, The Netherlands
- 12.00 Departure from the cemetery with suitable music whereby guests are invited to walk along the Cross of Sacrifice as a mark of honour.
Afterwards lunch at 'de Cantharel', Van Golsteinlaan 20, Ugchelen (A1, afrit / exit 19)
