What they do

The Fund offers support in the following areas:

- General needs grants
- Maintenance grants
- Home repairs and modifications
- Wheelchairs, scooters and mobility aids
- Domiciliary care and equipment
- Providing advice on sheltered housing
- Small business start up
- Resettlement, retraining and small business start-up
- Education grants
- Housing
- Short-term care and assistance with accessing and funding long-term care in third party homes
- Respite care
- Advocacy service on all aspects of care provision
